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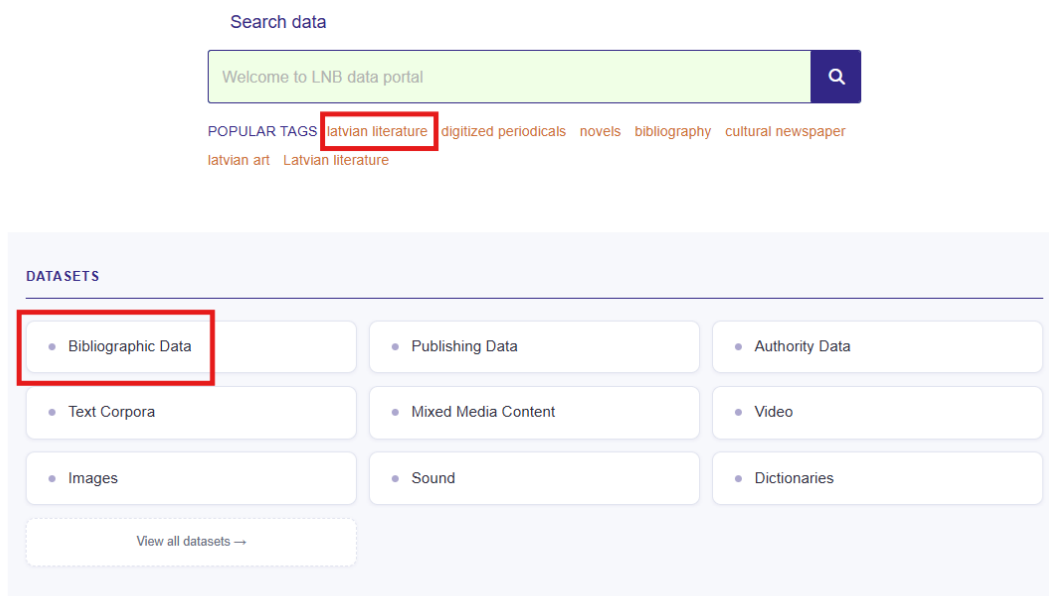
Abstract

This document contains user instructions for the NLL Data portal at dati.lnb.lv.

Guide

On the portal's home page, clicking on "[count] datasets" on the portal's home page redirects the user to an overview page listing all available datasets. By clicking on the name of a specific tag, the user is redirected to the dataset overview page listing datasets filtered by this tag. By clicking on the name of a specific dataset category, the user is redirected to the dataset overview page listing datasets filtered by this category.

On the dataset overview page, the separate types of filtering options (on the left side of the page) can be collapsed by clicking on the name of the filtering type (e.g. Categories).

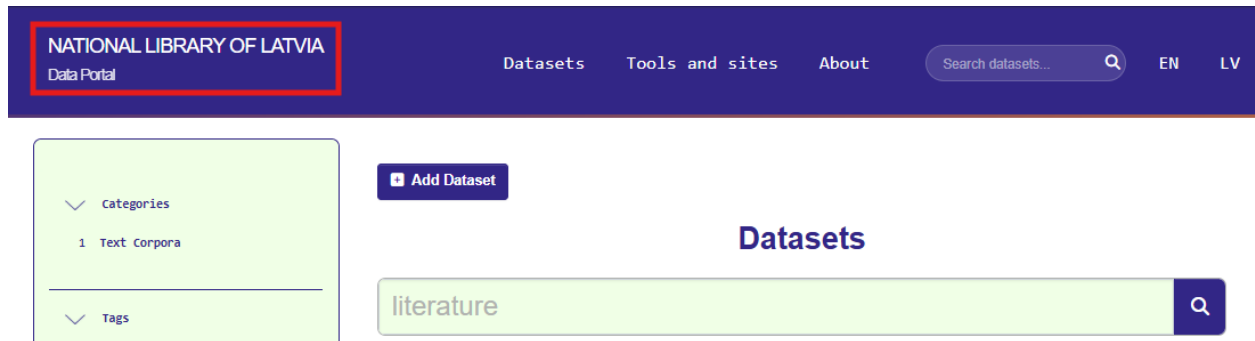
